

Anchor Safe™ Roll Goods Cleaning Instructions

Installation Instructions

- Clean & dry floor
- Use a cutting knife and cutting board to cut mat to size
- Position the mat then press and smooth into place with cutting board
- Cut all 4 corners at 45° angles

Replacement Frequency

- The Anchor Safe™ Roll Goods is designed to last up to 3 month under normal traffic conditions
- Replace the mat if it is installed in a high traffic area and shows obvious signs of wear or a weakened bond to the floor before the end of that time frame
- Do not pick up mat to clean the floor underneath until you are ready to replace it

Cleaning

- The Anchor Safe™ Roll Good can be left in place during daily cleaning
- Floor scrubbers, vacuums, brooms and mops pass right over without damaging the surface of the mat; use low settings for water and pressure
- Tougher stains may be pretreated with standard carpet cleaning products and agitated with a brush to loosen the soil

Drying

- The Anchor Safe™ Roll Good are highly absorbent and fast drying
- Absorbed water will evaporate; standard fans or floor blowers can be used to speed drying time
- For extremely wet conditions, use a wet vac or extractor to remove water
